## **Staff House Progress**

Construction of the staff house has advanced significantly. All plumbing pipe work is complete, and the electrical installations have been successfully finalized. The plastering phase is done, bringing us one step closer to transforming this structure into a warm and functional living and administrative space. Initially, this building will also serve as temporary living quarters for the children as we continue developing the rest of the campus. Another staff house is already rising from the ground, and we're also almost ready to break ground on the classroom block! Soon, children will have a space to learn, grow, and thrive in a nurturing Christian environment.

#### Water Access & Infrastructure

We are thrilled to report that **two wells have been successfully drilled**, ensuring a sustainable source of clean water for both the school and the surrounding community. A **pump house** has been built, and a **chain-link fence** now secures the area for safety and protection. **Water lines have been laid**, bringing fresh water directly to the **school** and to the **community**, a milestone that not only supports our students but also uplifts local families. We are now eagerly awaiting the **installation of solar panels** to power the water system sustainably.



### **Agricultural Growth**

Our **gardens and plantation** are thriving, a true testament to the blessings we've received:

- Banana plantations are lush and healthy
- Cassava and sweet potatoes are flourishing in the fields
- Fruit trees are maturing beautifully, promising nutrition for our future students
